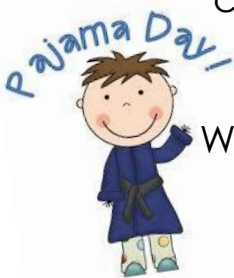

Registration for the **2020-2021 Early Learning & Kindergarten** programs at *Jennie Emery Elementary School* are open.



You may register between the hours of **9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.** Children are eligible to attend Kindergarten if they will be five years of age on or before December 31st, 2020. To be eligible for the Early Learning Program, your child must be four years of age on or before December 31st, 2020. Registration forms are available at the school office.

Please bring your child’s birth certificate or citizenship card/passport with you when you register for either of these programs.

For the **2020-2021 school year**, *J.E.E.S.* will again be offering a **full-day Kindergarten program**. The full-day program will consist of classes on either Mondays & Wednesdays with some additional Friday classes or Tuesdays & Thursdays with some additional Friday classes. All programs are filled on a **first come, first served basis** so please make sure to register as soon as possible if you require a specific day/program. ***Please note: There is currently a wait list for Tuesday/Thursday program.**

The **Early Learning Program** will again be offering **four half-day programs**, two days per week as follows: Monday & Wednesday mornings or afternoons as well as Tuesday & Thursday mornings or afternoons. All programs are filled on a **first come, first served basis** so please make sure to register as soon as possible if you require a specific day/program.

The cost for the **Early Learning Program** is **\$80.00 per month**. Please make post-dated cheques made payable to *Palliser Regional Schools* OR payment is available online beginning in September.
