### Celebrations:

Last year, there was a big concern regarding Work Preparation. We created a Discovery program that allowed students to participate in cross graded, co-curricular activities. We feel that having the opportunity to explore areas such as curling, drawing, musical instruments, fitness, yoga, computer coding and theatre increased student engagement and expanded children's areas of interest.

### Areas to watch

**Program of Studies** is still an area of concern, but we were able to recreate a music program throughout the school. We are also able to make changes to allow the continuation of skills rotations in most of our grades.

**Parent Involvement** is tricky. Historically, the reputation of the school has been great, but it has also consistently had difficulty getting parents involved. We are currently above the three year average, but lower than the provincial score. It is more important than ever to find ways to involve parents in our school.

## School Goals

### **Goal #1: Develop a school community that focuses on the complete child.**

Obviously academic success is important, but creating the appropriate environment is necessary before any learning can take place. We must develop a safe and caring school that allows learning to flourish. Considering the circumstances we face this year, it is important to make sure we are cognizant of the mental health of our whole school community.

## **Strategies**

Mission Statement: Use an adequate amount of time to take a journey through developing a mission statement for the school.

PLC Time: Teachers will meet with grade like teachers on a regular basis to investigate questions that will lead to improved instruction.

Grade Level Meetings: Admin, LST and FSL will meet with teachers of a specific grade to support teachers who have students with unique concerns. This allows for a team approach to addressing the needs of all students.

Staff Meetings: Provide time for support staff to attend staff meetings. By omitting these important employees, it creates barriers and tiers to a school community.

School Community Council: Continue to involve the Parent Council in decisions regarding the direction of the school.

## Goal #2: Improve student learning in the area of literacy and numeracy.

The primary goal of every school is student learning. We must find a way to improve what we are currently doing. We believe that by using data, we can determine areas where we are doing well and others where we can improve.

### Strategies

For this year, our main strategy is to collect and analyze data to see if there are opportunities for our teachers to improve instruction and, as a result, to influence student learning.

We have introduced the MIPI as a tool for our staff to use to assess cohorts of students and further inform their own practice.

Continue to use Fountas and Pinnell as a tool to support literacy.

We are exploring data options for us to further inform us regarding our practice. We are considering using CAT 4 as a tool to assist us in developing a baseline. This baseline will give us a starting point for moving forward.
