VOLUNTEERING & Criminal Record Checks

Parents/Guardians who wish to attend school field trips must submit a **Criminal Record Check**, with **Vulnerable Sector Check** to the JEES office.

According to Palliser School Division policy this check must be obtained from an accredited Police Agency (such as the R.C.M.P. or the Lethbridge Police Service.)

There is a form available from the JEES office, to take to the Police Station to request your CRC. If you are interested in volunteering at any time during the school year, or attending field trips with your child please submit your CRC to our office as soon as possible.

A CRC is valid in our office for 2 years from the date it was issued, however we must receive it within 3 months of the issue date. NO SCHOOL





This is a great opportunity for new players to try out the sport. If you have already played, BRING A FRIEND WITH YOU to try it!


