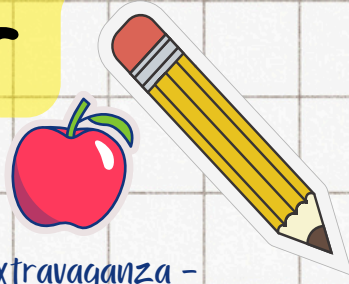

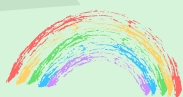

VOLUNTEERING & Criminal Record Checks

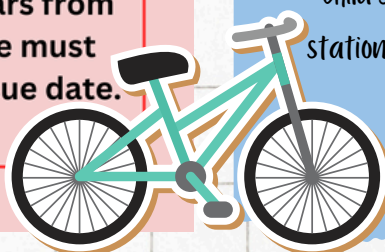
Parents/Guardians who wish to attend school
field trips must submit a **Criminal Record Check,**
with **Vulnerable Sector Check** to the JEES office.

*According to Palliser School Division policy this
check must be obtained from an accredited Police
Agency (such as the R.C.M.P. or the Lethbridge
Police Service.)*

There is a form available from the JEES office, to
take to the Police Station to request your CRC.

If you are interested in volunteering at any time
during the school year, or attending field trips with
your child please submit your CRC to our office as
soon as possible.

**A CRC is valid in our office for 2 years from
the date it was issued, however we must
receive it within 3 months of the issue date.**

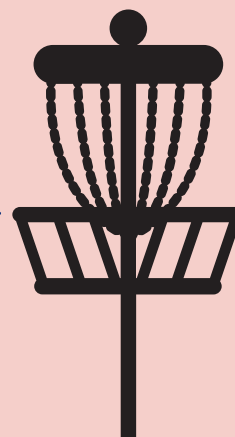

- Volunteers are needed for Fun Day on June 13th! Make sure you book the day off if you'd like to come help! Please watch for upcoming DOJO information.

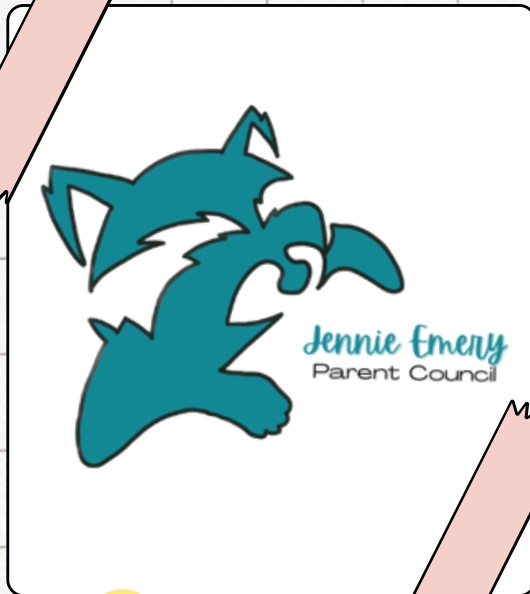
- The bottle depot accepts donations on behalf of FOJE and will accept bottles all summer long! Just let them know you'd like them to come to us!
