Board Highlights from November Meeting

- 1) The Palliser School Division, serving a geographically expansive and culturally rich region, is committed to fostering strong relationships with all members in the division. To support this goal, the Board has established an Engagement Committee tasked with informing, consulting and collaborating with school communities. The Engagement Committee will host three public engagement evenings, inviting stakeholders to explore their vision for the schools and the Division. The Board wishes to foster meaningful dialogue by gathering feedback from the participants to help with the decision making process to create a shared vision for the future. The Palliser School Division website will offer further announcements on the Board's Plans here: Palliser School Division Board Strategic Planning
- 2) The Board reviewed the Annual Education Results Report as part of Alberta's Assurance Framework, which aims to build public trust to ensure the education system meets student needs and fosters success. The Division continues to surpass provincial averages, with positive feedback from both parents and staff. However, one area of concern is student sentiment toward learning and engagement in school. School staff and Division leadership are working closely to identify strategies to address this concern. The report is scheduled for approval at the next Board meeting (Dec 10) pending the integration of additional information from audited financial statements. Once approved, the document will be made available on the Palliser website by Nov 30, 2024.
